The following points and proposals were discussed

Prize table With this years prize tables capped at £60 this year we have a £120 surplus (£80 surplus last year), with this in mind I propose the nearest the pin prize to be lifted next year from £10 to £15 and giving 3rd place £10 making the prizes as: 1st £30 2nd £20 3rd £10 with nearest the pin £15. With a new cap each game of £75 rather than £60 we could use this years surplus if needed for any shortfall, if this starts costing the society then we re-think the whole thing.

Sausage Hackers Trophy prizes, I propose we keep the prizes more in line with the 1862 games as follows As it's an away weekend prize table to be maybe £15 or £20 for the weekend 1st each day £30 2nd each day £20 3rd each day £10 All par 3 holes rather than just one to be nearest the pin @ £15 each Overall winner to receive the trophy only and not a cash prize.

Captain to use any surplus prize money for other spot prizes he wishes to do whether its secret pairs or anything else.

Passed that the Captain to discuss prize table with the committee prior to event

Handicaps I propose another slight alteration to the handicaps system next year using the same format as this year only staggering the shots back so you get less shots back for coming 6th and more back for coming 16th this was what I tried to do this year but the software wouldn't allow it, I can now see a way of doing this with general adjustments.

Best 5 from 8 alterations I propose we change the best 5 from 8 and make it best 6 from 8 or best 7 from 8

Agreed that we keep it at 5 from 8

Complimentary drinks I propose all that attend the AGM have one pint paid for by the society even if it means raising the subs by £5
